1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames made the above mentioned Order on 21 March 2022 under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Order which will be to impose a speed limit of 20 miles per hour in the roads listed in the Schedule to this Notice.

(Please note, for roads listed where a partial 20mph limit is already in place, the speed limit applies the whole length of that road) and the corresponding traffic order is either partially or fully revoked.

3. The made Orders which will come into effect on 25th March 2022 and plans can be inspected:

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order may make application for the purpose to the High Court by 9 May 2022.

**THE KINGSTON UPON THAMES (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
(NO. 1) TRAFFIC ORDER 2022**

Made: 21 March- 2022

Coming into force:-25 March 2022

The Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**(a)** as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985**(b)**, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into force on 28 March 2022 and may be cited as the Kingston upon Thames (20 mph Speed Limit) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2022.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any road or length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of the coming into force of this Order:
 - (a) The Kingston upon Thames (20 mph Speed Limit) (No. 3) Traffic Order 2004**(c)** shall have effect as though item 7 in the Schedule to that Order were omitted;
 - (b) The Kingston upon Thames (20 mph Speed Limit) (No. 2) Traffic Order 2005**(d)** shall have effect as though item 1 in the Schedule to that Order were omitted;
 - (c) The Kingston upon Thames (20 mph Speed Limit) (No. 2) Traffic Order 2011**(e)** is revoked;
 - (d) The Kingston upon Thames (20 mph Speed Limit) (No. 3) Traffic Order 2011**(f)** is revoked; and
 - (e) The Kingston upon Thames (20 mph Speed Limit) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2015**(g)** shall have effect as though items numbered 2, 3, 4, 8 and 9 in the Schedule to that Order were omitted.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011**(h)** when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

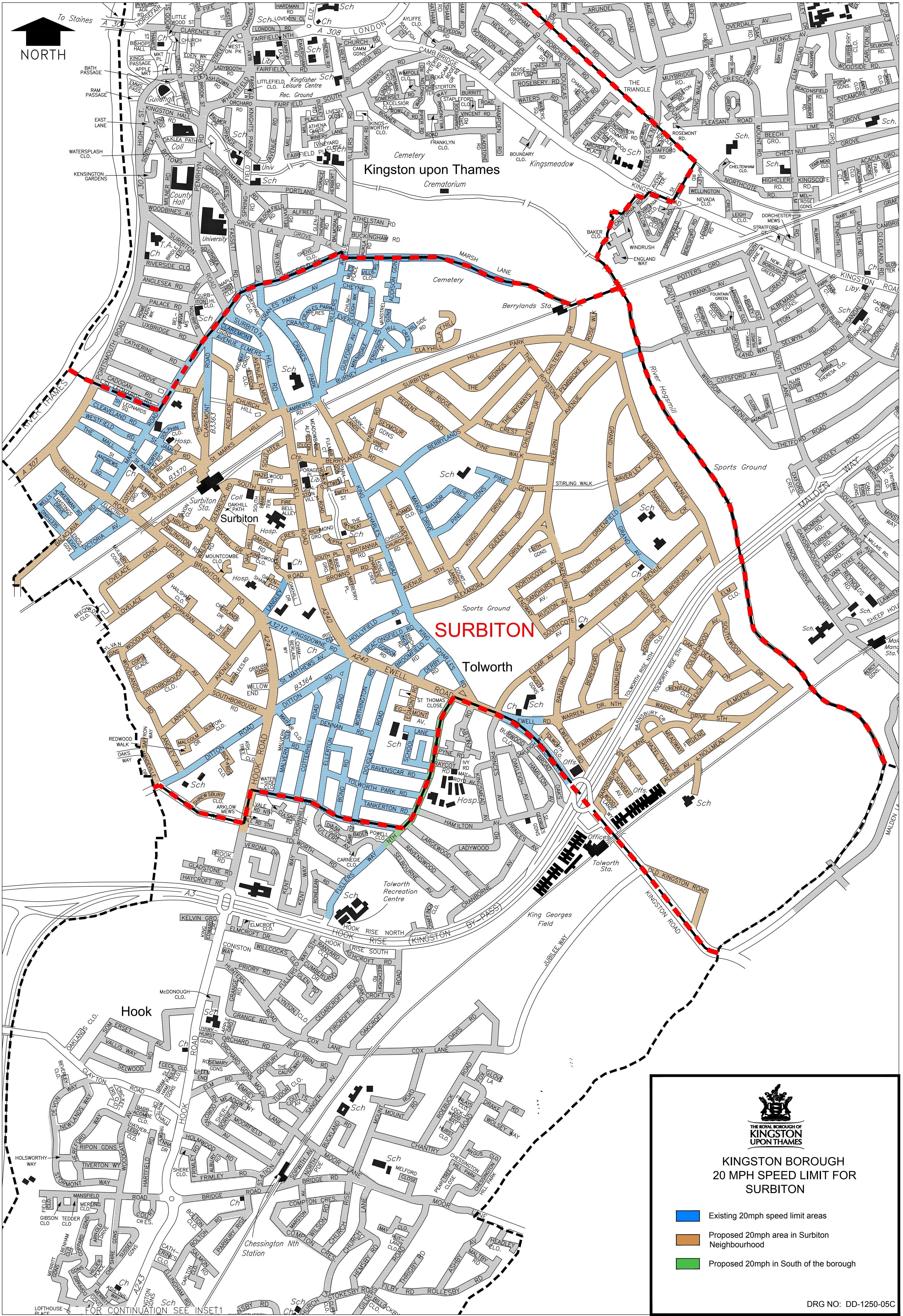

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order introduces a 20 mph speed limit throughout the Surbiton area.

The Order also revokes and re-enacts certain provisions of Orders (*detailed in Article 3*) which have previously imposed a 20 mph speed limit in parts of certain roads in Surbiton, so that the 20 mph speed limit now applies in the whole length of those roads.
