## ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES

### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and section 90 of the Highways Act 1980 that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames intends to relocate the existing zebra crossing in Red Lion Road, Tolworth, north of Tolworth Park Road, by approximately 13 metres northward, in connection with the widening of the northern access road to Tolworth Hospital.
2. The revised crossing will be constructed on a raised table road hump, level with the kerb with a width of approximately 6 metres.
3. The zig-zag markings at the crossing, which prohibit vehicles from stopping and overtaking, will extend for approximately 16 metres on the southern approach to the crossing and for approximately 8 metres on the northern approach.
4. In connection with the relocation of the zebra crossing the Council also intends to make "The Kingston upon Thames (Parking, Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. \* ) Order 202\*" under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
5. The general effect of the Order would be to:
  - (a) extend the existing double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions on the northern side of Tolworth Park Road into Red Lion Road for approximately 10 metres (adjacent to No. 125 Tolworth Park Road); and
  - (b) introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions at the junction of Red Lion Road and the widened northern access road into Tolworth Hospital (for approximately 5 metres on each side of the access road).

The Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, as amended, and all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Order:-

### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as **The Kingston upon Thames (Parking, Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. \*\*) Order 20\*\*** and shall come into force on \*\* \*\*\*\*\* 20\*\*.

### Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order:-

“Council” means the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames;

“map-based schedule” means the map attached to and to be read in conjunction with this Order, which depicts the parking places designated by this Order, and in conjunction with the map schedule legend, identifies the type of each particular parking place and, if appropriate, certain of its governing provisions:

Provided that the Council does not accept responsibility for any inaccuracies contained in the Ordnance Survey data relied upon to create the map based schedule and where a parking place, loading place or length of waiting restrictions is depicted in the map based schedule, that parking place, loading place or length of waiting or loading restrictions will continue to apply irrespective of any subsequent changes that have been made to the underlying Ordnance Survey data; and

“map schedule legend” means the map schedule legend presented with the map based schedule which, when used in conjunction with the map based schedule, the Articles of this Order,

“the Order of 2023” means **The Kingston upon Thames (Parking, Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2023**<sup>2</sup>.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment; and
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2023 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

#### Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2023 thereto

3. (1) Each area on a street identified in the map based schedule by way of the map schedule legend as a parking place or a loading place and, where applicable, by way of the map schedule legend, as an area marked out and signed for the use therein of specified classes of vehicles following the conditions specified in the Order of 2023 in relation to that type of parking place, is designated as a parking place.
- (2) Unless otherwise so identified, a parking place shall be bounded on one side of its length by the edge of the carriageway and be an area marked either by a traffic sign or by another method of indicating the extent of a parking place as specified in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>3</sup>.
- (3) The provisions of the Order of 2023 (other than Articles 4 and 16) shall apply to an area designated as a parking place or loading place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place or a loading place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place or a loading place by this Order.

#### Waiting restrictions applicable to restricted streets

4. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Order of 2023 shall have effect as though any waiting restriction identified in a map based schedule and, where applicable, by way of the map schedule legend, and marked out and signed as a waiting restriction shall be construed as through it were a restricted street referred to in the Order of 2023.

#### Placing of traffic signs, etc

5. The Council shall:

- (a) place and maintain traffic signs or other appropriate markings on the surface of the street indicating the limits of each parking place and each loading place designated by this Order; and
- (b) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of a parking place or a loading place.

Amendments to the Order of 2023

- 6. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order of 2023 is hereby varied as identified in the map-based schedule to this Order.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

The purpose of the Order is to.

- (a) reduce and amend certain lengths of parking restrictions to relocate the existing zebra crossing in Red Lion Road, Tolworth, north of Tolworth Park Road, by approximately 13 metres northward, in connection with the widening of the northern access road to Tolworth Hospital.
- (b) extend the existing double yellow line “at any time” waiting restrictions on the northern side of Tolworth Park Road into Red Lion Road for approximately 10 metres (adjacent to No. 125 Tolworth Park Road); and
- (c) introduce double yellow line “at any time” waiting restrictions at the junction of Red Lion Road and the widened northern access road into Tolworth Hospital (for approximately 5 metres on each side of the access road).

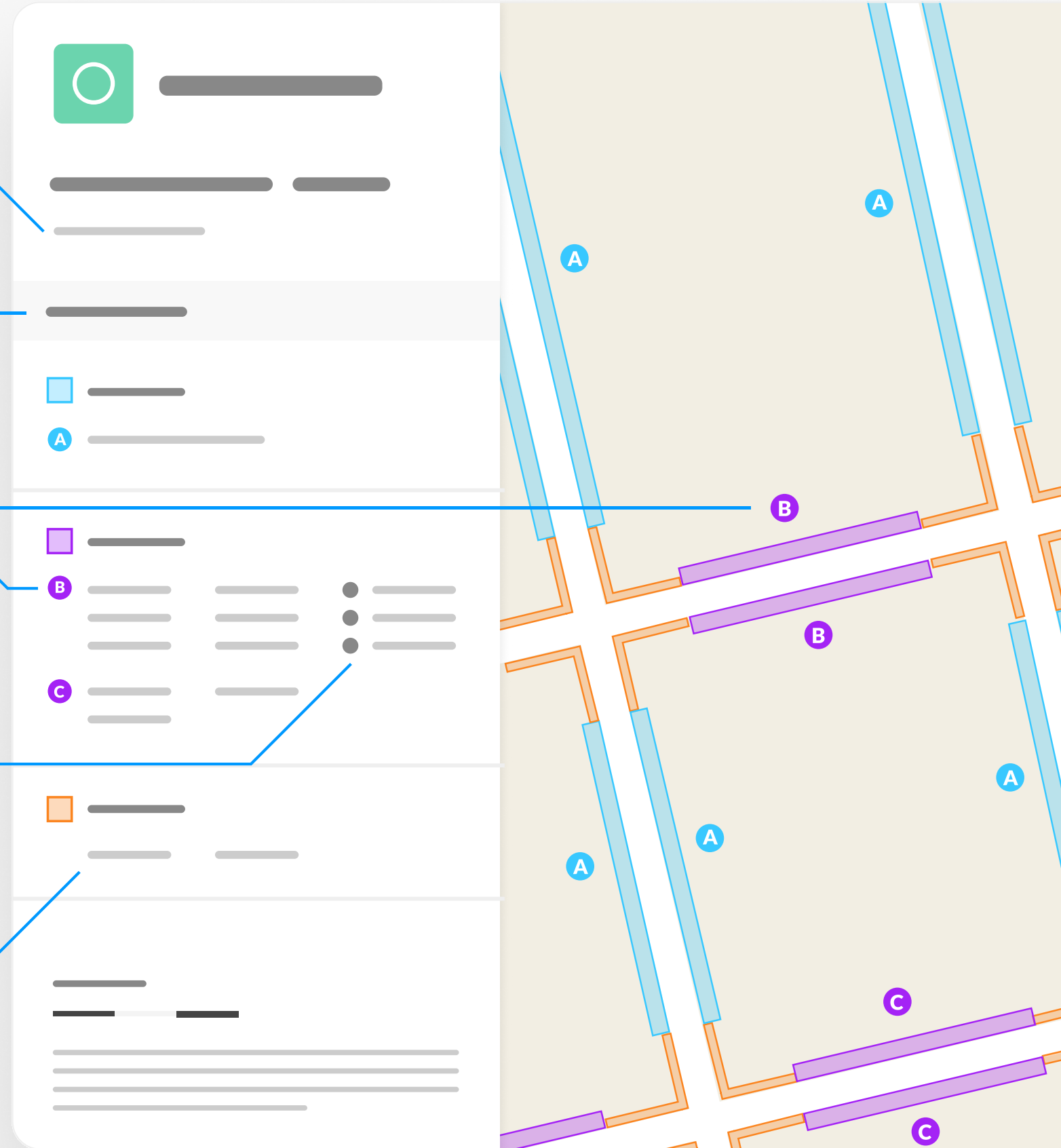
