1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the following Order The Kingston upon Thames (20mph Speed Limit) No. *) Traffic Order 202* Order under sections 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to impose a speed limit of 20 miles per hour in the roads listed in Kingston Hill between its junction with Queens Road and a point 150 metres east of its junction with Warren Road.

THE COUNCIL OF THE ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES, having consulted with the Commissioner of the Metropolitan Police, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on * 20** and may be cited as the Kingston upon Thames (20 mph Speed Limit) (No. *) Traffic Order 202*.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on Kingston Hill between its junction with Queens Road and a point 150 metres west of its junction with Warren Road.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of the coming into force of this Order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

This Order introduces a 20 mph speed limit in Kingston Hill between its junction with Queens Road and a point 150 metres west of its junction with Warren Road.
