Anyone attending the opening of postal votes should report to the MAIN reception in Guildhall and electoral services staff will escort you to the room where postal vote opening is taking place.

Candidates and election agents may attend the opening of postal votes. Each party or independent candidate may appoint as many agents as required to attend the opening of postal votes – however a maximum of **three** agents per party or independent candidate may attend the opening session at any one time. This may be reduced to **two** each if the Deputy Returning Officer considers the room to be overcrowded.

Names of those attending should be notified before the commencement of proceedings.

It is advisable to check with Electoral Services beforehand, in case volumes of returned envelopes mean a session is cancelled or the time changed.
