CONSIDERATE CONSTRUCTORS SCHEME



We arrived to site in late July and had a busy start with only just over five weeks to complete the WC refurbishment in the Infant School. This is pushing ahead in preparation for the children's return in early September. Across the rest of the site, we're diverting services and setting up with temporary accommodations and hoardings alongside the piling mat installation. Those of you that can see the works will note that we keep on top of dust where possible by using water suppression and also have dust, noise and vibration monitors set to alert us to ensure that surrounding neighbours are inconvenienced as little as possible.

As you may have noted, the pathway into and out of Blagdon Park from Burlington Road has had to be closed as it leads directly onto access for the construction site, which is where all site traffic, plant and deliveries are being routed throughout the project.

The pathway will have no access available during the following times:

Monday—Friday 07:00-18:00 and occasionally Saturdays 07:00 - 13:00

A gated entrance has been created that will be open outside of site working hours.
