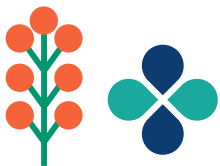




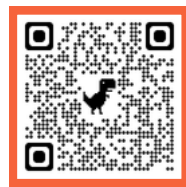
Maldens & Coombe
