Your rights



- You have the right to receive support such as:
- <u>Health care</u>
- <u>Education</u> (children **must** be educated)
- Public funds
- Integration support please contact your council



 There are laws to protect you when you are working; you have <u>rights as an</u> <u>employee</u>.



- You are entitled to:
- a minimum wage
- to receive paid holiday
- not to be overworked.



- You have the right:
- to liberty
- to freedom of thought
- to marry

• You are expected to stick to a set of core values and responsibilities.



- These core values include to:
- Respect and obey the law
- Respect the rights and opinions of others
- Treat others with fairness



For London




- Learn about your local area and how to access services.

• Join a club, take up a sport or volunteer


- <u>Connected Kingston</u> has lots of ideas to help you integrate into life in Kingston and <u>Volunteering Kingston</u> has volunteering options.
