Statement of Reason

To improve parking availability for residents, Highways and Transportation are proposing a 'Permit Parking Area' in the California Road area to operate Monday to Saturday between, 8:30am - 6:30pm

## ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the following Order The Kingston upon Thames (Parking, Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. \*) Order 202\*. under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 (insofar as applicable) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended:
2. The general effect of the Order would be to introduce a system of controlled parking (known as a Permit Parking Area - PPA) in:

**Barker Close, California Road, England Way, Georgia Road, Nevada Close, Oregon Close, Sherfield Close, Springfield Place, Virginia Close, Willow Road and Windrush.**

The Order relating to this PPA (DJ) would provide that;

- (a) the hours of control (the "permitted hours") in the PPA would apply Monday to Saturday between 8.30am and 6.30pm;
- (b) vehicles which may be left in the PPA during its permitted hours would be those displaying a valid resident's or resident's visitor permit relating to this PPA;

resident's permits would be issued by the Council, on application being made together with payment of the appropriate charge. Properties eligible for a permit are all properties in **Barker Close, California Road, England Way, Georgia Road, Nevada Close, Oregon Close, Sherfield Close, Springfield Place, Virginia Close, Willow Road and Windrush**, and Nos. 224a, 226a, 228a, 230a, 232a, 234a, 238a, 240a, 242a, 246a, 246b, 248b, 248c and Flats above 236 and 244 **Kingston Road**.

The Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 (insofar as applicable) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, as amended, and all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Order:-

### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as **The Kingston upon Thames (Parking, Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. \*) Order 202\*** and shall come into force on \* Month 202\*.

### Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order:-

“Council” means the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames;

“map-based schedule” means the map attached to and to be read in conjunction with this Order, which depicts the parking places and loading places designated by this Order and the waiting restrictions imposed by this Order, and in conjunction with the map schedule legend, identifies the type of each particular parking place, loading place and waiting restriction and, if appropriate, certain of its governing provisions:

Provided that the Council does not accept responsibility for any inaccuracies contained in the Ordnance Survey data relied upon to create the map based schedule and where a parking place, loading place or waiting restriction is depicted in the map based schedule, that parking place, loading place or waiting restriction will continue to apply irrespective of any subsequent changes that have been made to the underlying Ordnance Survey data;

“map schedule legend” means the map schedule legend presented with the map based schedule which, when used in conjunction with the map based schedule, identifies the specific type of parking places and loading places designated by this Order, and the waiting restrictions imposed by this Order and, where appropriate, certain of their governing provisions; and

“the Order of 2023” means The Kingston upon Thames (Parking, Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2023<sup>2</sup>.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment; and
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2023 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

#### Designation of parking places and loading places and application of the Order of 2023 thereto

3. (1) Each area on a street identified in the map based schedule by way of the map schedule legend as a parking place or a loading place and, where applicable, by way of the map schedule legend, as an area marked out and signed for the use therein of specified classes of vehicles following the conditions specified in the Order of 2023 in relation to that type of parking place or loading place, is designated as a parking place or a loading place, as the case may be.
- (2) Unless otherwise so identified, a parking place shall be bounded on one side of its length by the edge of the carriageway and be an area marked either by a traffic sign or by another method of indicating the extent of a parking place or loading place, as the case may be, as specified in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>3</sup>.
- (3) The provisions of the Order of 2023 (other than Articles 4 and 16) shall apply to an area designated as a parking place or loading place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place or a loading place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place or a loading place, as the case may be, by this Order.

#### Waiting restrictions applicable to restricted streets

4. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Order of 2023 shall have effect as though any waiting restriction identified in the map based schedule and, where applicable, by way of the map schedule legend, and marked out and signed as a waiting restriction shall be construed as though it were a restricted street referred to in the Order of 2023.

#### Placing of traffic signs, etc

5. The Council shall:
  - (a) place and maintain traffic signs or other appropriate markings on the surface of the street indicating the limits of each parking place and each loading place designated by this Order; and
  - (b) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of a parking place or a loading place, as the case may be.

Amendments to the Map Schedule to the Order of 2023

6. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order of 2023 shall have effect as though any parking place or loading place or waiting, loading or stopping restriction depicted in the map-based schedule to this Order as being:

(a) introduced by this Order: replaced the details, including the absence thereof, for the same locations in the Map Schedule of the Order of 2023.

(b) removed or replaced by this Order: removed or replaced those for the same locations in the Map Schedule of the Order of 2023,

(c) and any such removal or replacement shall have the effect of revoking any such provision so removed or replaced.

7. There was added to article 3(1) of that Order under "Permit Parking Area

Part IX – California Road Permit Parking Area (DJ)

8. There was added as Part IX to Schedule 3 to that Order the heading as set out in the Schedule to this Order.

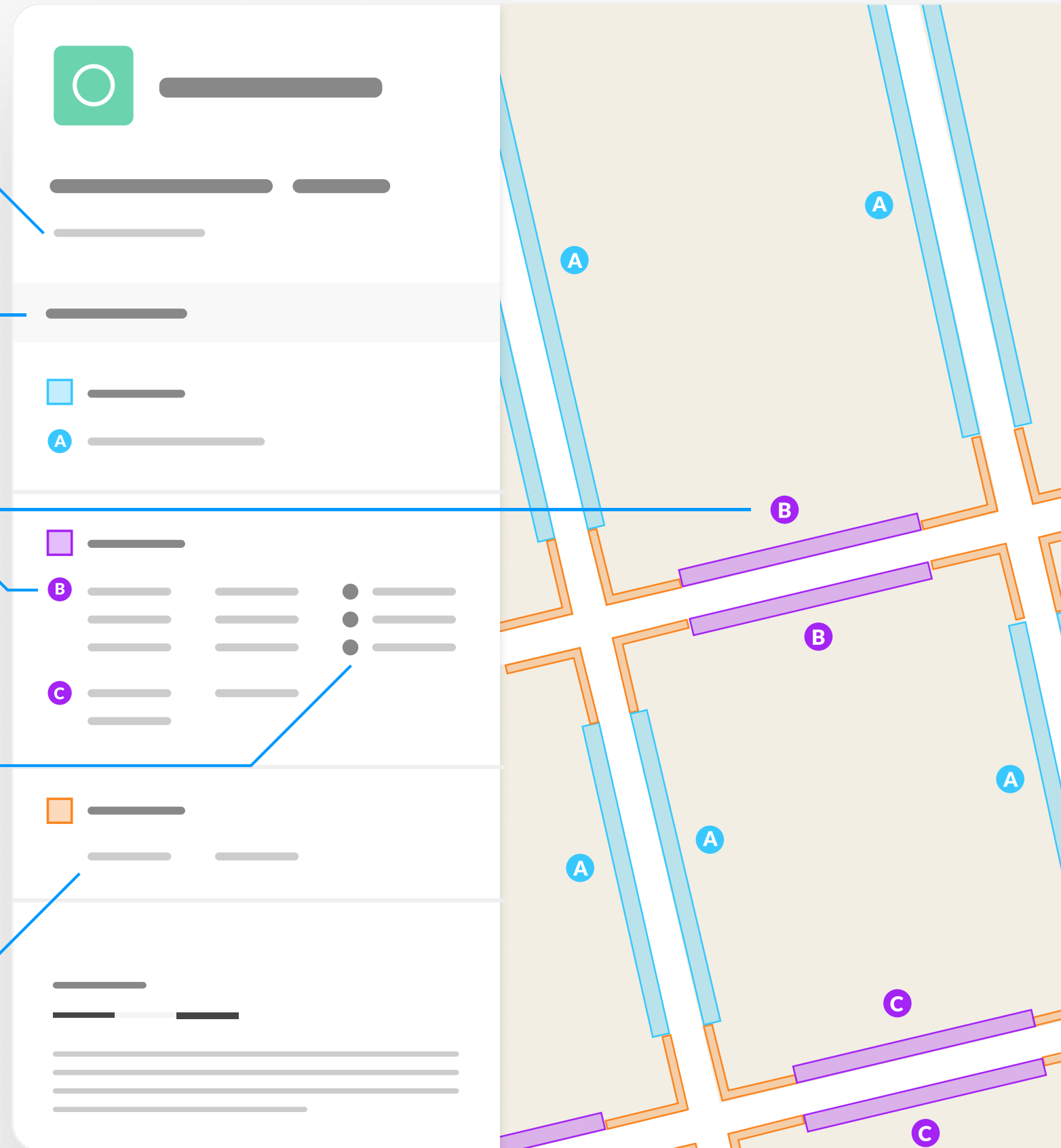
