2024/25 Retail, Hospitality and Leisure Discount Scheme

The 2024/25 Retail, Hospitality and Leisure Business Rates Discount scheme will provide eligible, occupied, retail, hospitality and leisure ratepayers with a 75% discount, up to a cash cap limit of £110,000 per business. Qualification is dependent on the new UK subsidy control regime which commenced 4 January 2023. Information about subsidy control can be found on the gov.uk website.

If you think that you are entitled to receive the Retail, Hospitality and Leisure Discount, then you should contact the Council.

If you are currently receiving the discount and do not qualify, you must write to the Council within the next twenty-one days to confirm that you need to have the discount removed from your bill.
